- To mature into deeper intimacy and friendship with the Triune God
- To develop a theology of Christian spirituality by drawing on and integrating insights from Scripture, theology, historical traditions, psychology and related fields
- To discover the richness of one’s own spiritual tradition and the gifts and blessings of other traditions
- To learn about, and engage in, spiritual habits and practices that facilitate spiritual growth
- To grow in balancing prayer, study and service and in developing practical wisdom based on Scripture, tradition, reason, and experience
- To gain experience and skills in providing individual and group spiritual direction in a Christ-centered program and context
- To participate in a creative partnership among Christian spiritual directors in the Southwest

Certificate Program Retreats and Dates. All on-site retreats take place at Saint Barnabas on the Desert Episcopal Church in Scottsdale, AZ unless otherwise announced. **Zoom Retreats for Year One** will begin on Thursdays @ 2:00, ending with fellowship hour @ 5:00. Friday and Saturday begin @ 9:00 am, ending at 5:00 pm.

Year One - Focus on Christian formation and introduction to the art of spiritual direction

Year Two - For those continuing, focus now is on supervised training in spiritual direction

Costs:

Due to the COVID Virus, year one will meet on the Zoom platform, providing a safe and accessible environment, while lowering the cost.

Tuition for year one will be **\$1,500**. This tuition covers 10 days of instruction, program faculty, guest faculty, curriculum, resources, administrative costs and other materials. An additional **Mini-Retreat** day takes place on a Saturday in August between years one and two.

If year two continues using the **Zoom** platform, tuition will also be **\$1,500**. If it is decided to hold year two **on-site**, tuition will be **\$1,960** to provide for catered meals (breakfast lunch, snacks, one dinner and graduation banquet) and facility rental. Year two also provides monthly individual or group supervision with a certified, trained supervisor for ongoing evaluation and training. Not

included are costs for transportation, overnight accommodations, and fees, if any, for individual spiritual direction and monthly personal retreat days.

A \$50 non-refundable processing fee is due with application and \$360 is due at time of admission to the program to reserve a place, as space is limited. Remaining tuition for the Program is due in advance on a yearly or term basis or by arrangement.

Entry Requirements

Admission is open to individuals (lay or clergy) from any Christian denomination or group, who have a bachelor's degree or its equivalent and/or have training or demonstrable knowledge of Scripture and theology. Life experience is highly valued as is awareness of a potential call to be a spiritual director. Admission to the program is granted when the following steps have been completed:

- A completed application submitted by September 15. Earlier application is encouraged because the size of a class is limited and may be closed before the deadline.
- A \$50 non-refundable processing fee made out to CFDM Arizona.
- A statement detailing educational background, work experience, Christian journey, involvement in church and Christian service, and interest in spiritual formation and spiritual direction.
- Two letters of reference (one pastoral and one personal)
- An interview with one of the Program Faculty/Staff

Upon receipt of application you will be contacted for an interview.

Note: Admission is open to individuals, lay or clergy, from any Christian denomination or group who has a bachelor's degree or its equivalent and/or has training or demonstrable knowledge of Scripture and theology. Life experience is highly valued as is awareness of a potential call to be a spiritual director. Admission to the program is granted by the Admissions Committee [composed of Faculty and Staff of the Certificate Program] following receipt of a completed application and an interview with one or more members of the Admissions Committee.

Cost for year one of the two-year program is \$1,500 on the **Zoom** platform. First year tuition covers ten days of instruction, program faculty, guest faculty, resources, administrative costs and other materials.

For year two, tuition will be determined by whether or not the Retreats are held **on Zoom or on-site**. Year two tuition will be \$1,500 on the **Zoom** platform. It covers nine days of instruction and practicum, program faculty, guest faculty, resources, administrative costs, and other materials. Also included is monthly individual or group supervision with a certified supervisor for ongoing evaluation and training.

If **on-site**, tuition will be \$1,960 as it will include catering for one dinner, breakfast, lunch and snacks for two days, a graduation banquet and facility rental. Not included are costs for transportation, overnight accommodations, and fees, if any, for individual spiritual direction and monthly personal retreat days. A \$50 non-refundable processing fee is due with application and \$360 is due at time of admission to the program [to reserve a place—space is limited] and remaining tuition for the Program is due in advance on a yearly or term basis, or by arrangement.

3. Have you ever had any spiritual formation or spiritual direction training? If so, please describe.
4. Do you have any theological training (i.e. seminary, bible school, courses, workshops)? Please be specific.
5. How/where did you find out about this program in spiritual formation and direction?
6. What do you hope to receive from this program?
7. What is going on internally within you that is leading you to seek out spiritual formation and direction training?
8. If you are married, describe your spouse's response to your desire to be in this program.
9. Describe your spiritual journey and your relationship with God at this time.
10. What do you see as your strengths? Weaknesses?
11. Describe any steps you have taken or experiences you explore (i.e. counseling, spiritual direction, journaling, group work, etc.) to pursue emotional health and growth.
12. We believe it is God's desire that individuals not only grow in experiential knowledge of God but also in experiential knowledge of self. Therefore, one main focus of this program will be to take an in-depth and very honest look at yourself and your life – your relationship with God, your relationship with others, your giftings, strengths, weaknesses, wounds, addictions, etc.
